<sup>[2]</sup> Indicate the group size in case of group work.

<sup>[3]</sup> Delete what is not applicable: For assignments and projects, list the deliverables, and –if applicable- other things you will you will assess them on (for example attitude and skills). For exams, list the question types (open, closed, etc.).
